

The Investigator Cabernet Franc 2006 Kangaroo Island as reviewed by Julia Harding

Named after HMS Investigator, which carried Captain Matthew Flinders on a journey which included the first European discovery of Kangaroo Island. Schist and clay soils. Aged in foudres for 2 years.

Colour of bruised cherry. Refined and inviting aroma of lightly minty dark fruit with a dash of spice but no intrusive sweetness. Gorgeously silky and fresh on the palate. Carressing and elegant and long yet stil with a bit of tannic resistance on the finish to have some life ahead of it. Utterly drinkable with a lovely note of red fruit at the very end. (JH)
