## THE RED 2010

The Red 2010 is a house-blend created by Jacques Lurton to complement the premium range of wines from The Islander Estate Vineyards.

### Wine Notes:

2010 was an excellent vintage on Kangaroo Island and The Red 2010 carries all the hallmarks of a great wine from that year. Made from Malbec, Cabernet Franc, Shiraz-Viognier and Bush Vine Grenache this is a modern Australian red wine. Ripe fruit flavours are supported by a savoury structure making this an excellent food wine. 18 months in French oak has added the extra touch of elegance to be expected from master French winemaker and The Islander Estate Vineyard's owner Jacques Lurton.
