The White 2012 is a house-blend created by Jacques Lurton to complement the premium range of wines from The Islander Estate Vineyards.

Wine Notes:

2012 is one of the best vintages Jacques has experienced on Kangaroo Island. The ripening period was steady and produced superb results across the range of varieties on The Islander Estate Vineyards.

The White 2012 is made from Semillon (70%) and Viognier (30%). It is a modern Australian white wine with delicious fruit flavours beautifully framed by natural acidity with a gentle kiss of spice at the finish. A touch of French oak adds the elegance and texture to be expected from master French winemaker and The Islander Estate Vineyard's owner Jacques Lurton
